

Student visa Nationality changes within the UK

- This document is intended to provide guidance to University of Cambridge students on the process to reflect nationality changes to UKVI.
- It has been prepared by the University's International Student Office using screen shots from the Home Office website.
- Students are advised to read this guidance as well as UKVI guidance prior to making an application.
- If you are inside the UK and have changed your nationality you must apply for a new BRP.
- You must do this within 3 months of obtaining your new nationality.
- The application costs £180.20 which includes the £19.20 fee to enrol your biometrics.

Update, replace or transfer your biometric residence permit (BRP)

You can use this form to get a **biometric residence permit (BRP)** if you are in the UK and if:

- · your BRP or other immigration document is lost, stolen, damaged
- your BRP or other immigration document has expired after you have received indefinite leave to remain
- your UK visa is in a passport that is lost, stolen, damaged, or expired
- you have changed your name, nationality, facial appearance, date of birth, or gender
- · you want to transfer or upgrade your old immigration document to a BRP

If your BRP has less than 3 months validity you may want to replace it now if you need to prove your right to work or rent or you are travelling outside the UK.

You do not need to apply for a replacement BRP if you currently have an application with the Home Office for further leave to remain or indefinite leave to remain.

This is the relevant option to your circumstances.



How to apply

To apply for a replacement BRP or BRC you need to:

- · fill in the application form
- · have your documents ready
- · pay the application fee
- have your biometrics taken (fingerprints and a photo)

You will need to complete a new application for each dependant applying for a BRP or BRC.

You will be able to save your application and come back to it another time if you need to.

The process for obtaining a replacement BRP once you have changed nationality is summarised here.

How we use your data

The Home Office will use the personal information you provide to consider your application. We may also share your information with other public and private sector organisations in the UK and overseas. For more detail please see the <u>Privacy Notice for the Border, Immigration and Citizenship system</u>. This also sets out your rights under the Data Protection Act 2018 and explains how you can access your personal information and complain if you have concerns about how we are using it.

A National Insurance number is required to work in the UK. As a student, you are not automatically issued with one. You would normally need to have applied for one if you were intending to work in the UK.

Convictions and other penalties

You will also be asked to confirm you are a person of good character and asked some details about your employment history.
