

Who is required to register?

The Immigration Act 1971 requires foreign nationals aged 16 years or over from the countries listed below to register with the police.

Note: If your visa states 'register with the police' this should be done within seven working days of arrival in the United Kingdom.

Failure to register is a criminal offence and could result in your removal from the United Kingdom.

What you will need to bring:

- Your passport/travel document
- Two passport size photographs
- Registration fee of £34.00
- Your work permit/contract of employment/letter from school or college

How to register?

The registration of foreign nationals will be carried out by the Overseas Visitors Registration Department at Parkside Police Station in Cambridge.

Registration is strictly by **appointment only**.
